Naloxone (Narcan)

- The CP program aims at preventing death from opioid overdoses in Onslow County by:
 - Offering education on recognition of an opioid overdose, what to do, and how to use naloxone.
 - Classes are offered to the general public, law enforcement agencies, county agencies and community partners.
 - The CP program has provided naloxone kits in public buildings that house their own AEDs through grant funding.
